Two Day Excursion to the historic village of Zaros, Phaestos & Matala in Eastern Crete-July 24-26, 2025

Join us for this unique program that explores new sites near Iraklion and Eastern Crete.

Zaros is a particularly attractive, an unspoiled village famous for its spring water, which is now bottled and sold all over Crete. Zaros also has some fine Byzantine monasteries and an emerald-green Lake Votomos (actually a reservoir). The lake is also the kick-off point for the 5km hike trail through the impressive Rouvas Gorge, a major lure for hikers, birders, and naturalists.

Phaestos was the second-most-important Minoan palace-city after Knossos and enjoys an awe-inspiring setting with panoramic views of the Messara Plain and Mt Psiloritis. It was built around 1700 BC atop an older, previously destroyed palace, and laid out around a central court.

Matala Caves were created in the Neolithic Age. Matala was the port of Phaistos during the Minoan period. In the year 220 BC, It has been suggested that the caves were once used as tombs, but it is more likely that they were used as living spaces. In the 1960s, the caves were occupied by famous hippies who were later driven out
